



Expressions of Interest Sought

Independent Governor

The Board of the Diabetes Association of the NT Inc., trading as Healthy Living NT, is seeking expressions of interest from community members in the NT to serve as an independent Governor on the Bill Raby Diabetes Fellowship Governing Board.

The Fellowship aims to enhance the well-being of people with diabetes and the general community in the NT. Fellowship financial support can be made available to applicants in the following two categories:

- a) Youth affected by diabetes
- b) Community-based health promoting projects

Since 2016, funding of ~\$138,000 has been awarded to 55 community health promoting projects and youth with diabetes:

- 23 youth with diabetes (type 1 and type 2) have been supported to attend both NT and
 interstate diabetes camps and to link into diabetes support networks using contemporary
 media. Over \$16,000 has been awarded directly to youth with diabetes.
- 32 community groups have been supported to initiate a range of health promoting projects as diverse as community health education and support, diabetes youth support, community cookbooks and healthy eating projects, community and school gardens and physical activity projects or equipment. ~\$122,000 has been awarded directly to community organisations.

Fellowship Board of Governors

A Fellowship Board of Governors appointed by, and reporting to, the Healthy Living NT Board oversees the operations, and advises on the strategic directions, of the Fellowship. The prime functions and responsibilities of the Fellowship Governing Board include:

- 1. Acting as sole arbiter on applications, award of Fellowships, funding levels and assessment of outcomes.
- 2. Providing strategic advice on the development and direction of the Fellowship, and
- 3. Assisting with promotion of the Fellowship.

Governors are appointed on the basis of their expertise/eminence in their particular field and knowledge of the NT community. All appointments are on an honorary basis for a minimum term of 3 years.

Current Fellowship Governors include Mr Gerry Wood (Chair), Ms Sue Korner, Mr Ken Vowles and Mr William De Decker (HLNT President).

Formal meetings are conducted twice a year via videoconference with ad hoc decision making conducted via email when necessary.

Healthy Living NT provides Fellowship funding, secretariat and grant administration support.
